- Air your dogs in areas where you will not disturb test in progress.
- Keep out of all ponds in the hunt test areas.
- Dogs are to be leashed or crated at all times when not participating in hunt test.

Please take the opportunity to thank the property owners Ricky Moore, Mark Pousson and Herb Doucet, judges and other volunteers that are needed to put on an event such as ours. Without these people working diligently prior to and during the event, it would not be possible.

IMPORTANT: To receive a refund, you must request the refund in writing; provide a self-addressed stamped envelope (SASE); and veterinarian certificate to the Lake Charles Retriever Club Event Secretary within 10 days following the test. Send refund request, veterinarian certificate and SASE to:

For those entering female dogs, please plan to be at Hunt Headquarters (Welch Multi-Purpose Building) for a bitch check at 6:00AM. You will not be allowed to run your female dog until she has received a "clear check" card, which must be presented to the Stake Marshal.
